

Instant Nonfat Dry Milk

Application:

Instant Nonfat Dry Milk is made by removing the water and fat from cows' milk to produce a dried product uniform in particle size that reconstitutes with ease. It can be used as a beverage, in beverage products and for cooking purposes. All the protein, B Vitamins, calcium and other minerals provided in whole milk remain. Instant milk is naturally good--no artificial ingredients have been added. Use the required amount of liquefied instant milk whenever recipes call for milk. Minimum level for Vitamin A is 2,000 IU/reconstituted quart and for Vitamin D is 400 IU/reconstituted quart.

Packaging:

Instant Nonfat Dry Milk is packed in 5 pound bags, 6 bags per case, in 25 pound and 50 pound polyethylene-lined multi-wall bags, and in totes. Your Berkshire Dairy Sales Representative can furnish information concerning special packaging.

Stability:

Store in cool (<80°F), dry (<65%RH) place. Shelf life is one year from date of manufacture.

Extra Grade Nonfat Dry Milk, Lactose, Vitamin A Palmitate and Vitamin D₃.

Mixing Instructions:

Use in liquid form $\underline{\text{exactly}}$ like fresh, fluid milk. If possible, mix the night before using, chill thoroughly, serve cold.

To Make 1 Quart Nonfat Milk:

Add 3.2 oz. (1-1/2 to 1-2/3 cups) Instant Nonfat Dry Milk to

3-3/4 cups of water.

To Make 5 Quarts Nonfat Milk:

Add 1 lb. Instant Nonfat Dry Milk to 18-3/4 cups of water

(approximately 4-2/3 quarts).

To Make 25 Quarts Nonfat Milk:

Add contents of a 5 lb. bag of Instant Nonfat Dry Milk to 93-

3/4 cups of water (approximately 23-1/2 quarts).
