EVAPORATED MILK

PRODUCT

INFORMATION: Evaporated milk is the liquid food obtained by the partial removal of water only from milk. It contains not less than 6.5% by weight of milkfat and not less than 23% by weight of total milk solids. Evaporated milk contains added Vitamin D. It is homogenized. It is sealed in a container and so processed by heat, after sealing, as to prevent spoilage. (CFR 131.130)

NOMENCLATURE: The name of the food is "Evaporated Milk". The phrase "Vitamin D" or "Vitamin D Added" shall immediately precede or follow the name of the food.

INGREDIENTS: Milk, Dipotassium Phosphate and Carrageenan (Stabilizers), Vitamin D₃.
